Reaching the venue from the Kolkata Airport:

Take the Kalyani Expressway

Take a right turn at "Kampa More" (close to Kanchrapara railway station) and drive to Bara Jagulia (about 9 km).

Take a left turn to be on National Highway 34 (NH34).

Drive for 1.7 km. The approach road to IISER-K (IISER-K connector road in Google map) would be on your left (the place is "4 no gate" stop for buses/auto rickshaws).

The total distance is about 50 km. If needed, the contact details of a vehicle for pickup at the airport will be provided.

Accommodation: Accommodation will be arranged in the Visitors' Hostel on Campus or at a nearby hotel just outside. Please inform the local host at least two weeks in advance.
